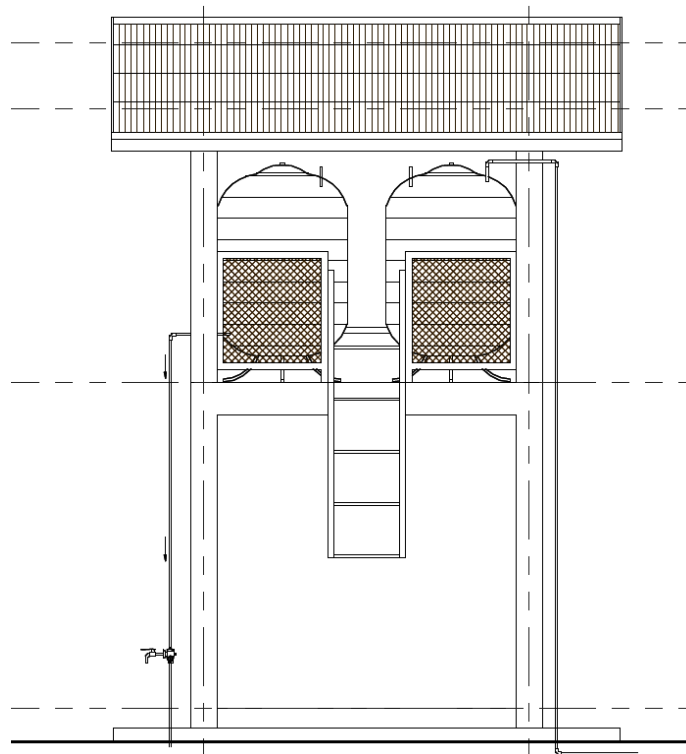

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Ano is a one of 5 health centers of La district, there are 5 nurses to working that covers 6 villages, the population of 2,742 with 3 ethnic groups, it includes 81% Akha, 11% Khmou and 7 % LaoSoong (Hmong). 100% of the land being high mountains, the economy is mainly agricultural and farming.

The roads to most villages are in very poor condition and driving is challenging which makes access to these villages difficult.

Ano Health Center is far from L a city 28 km on dirt road (take 2 hours).

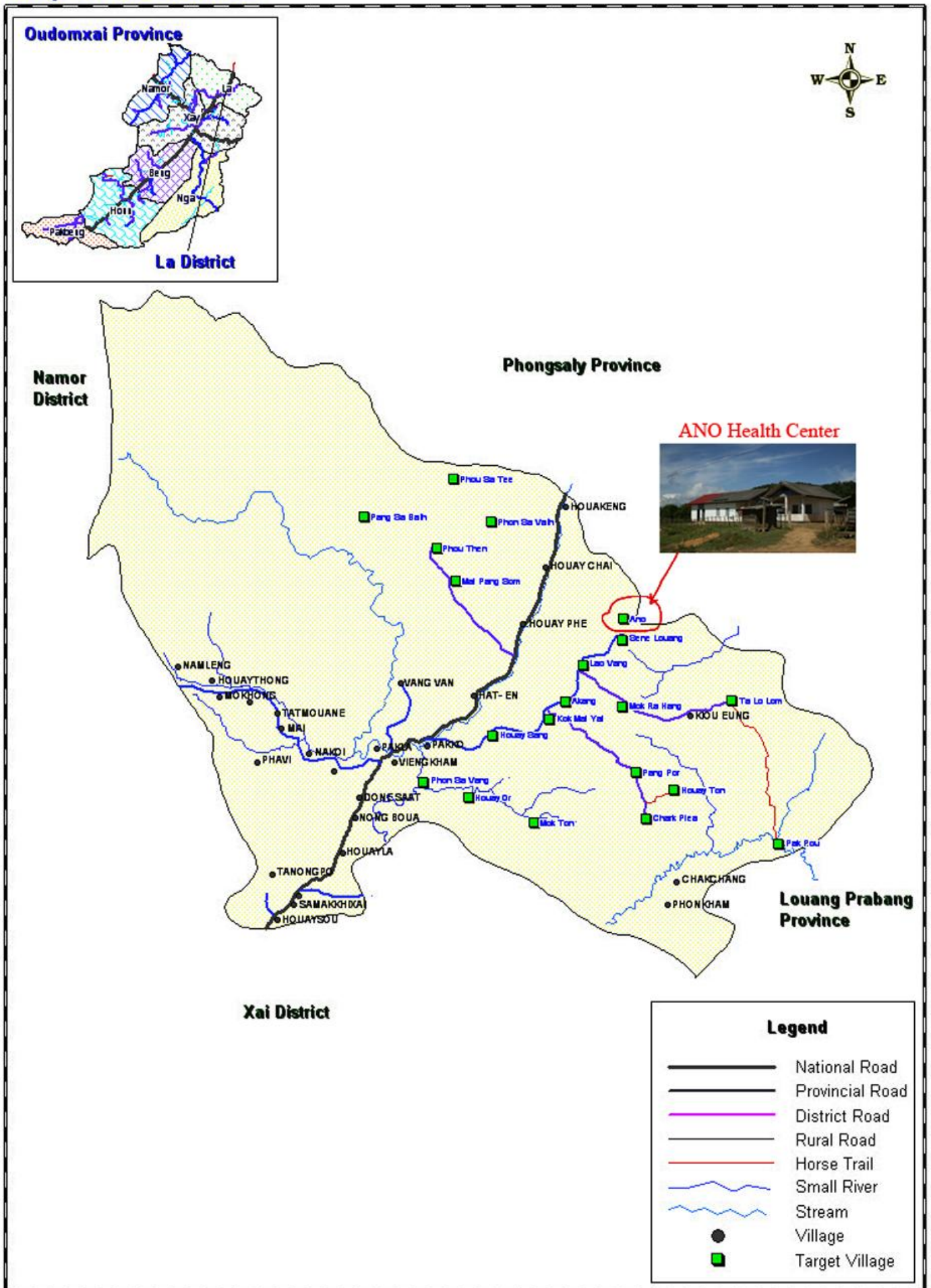
The main activity health care at health center services prevention and health education include vaccine injections, vitamin A, and parasite medication, basic treatment and refer for some cases.

The health center has done access to clean water (Gravity Water Project) in 2002 but no water enough to use because the water is running at night with is limited the storage tank and more population to use. During the patient was coming to health services at health center the water is limited the patients should help by themselves. The number of services per month averages of 280 OPD cases, 22 admitted ward and 5 pregnant delivery.

The purpose of storage water tank construction would result in helping and save clean water to access to water at the health center will improve quality of life particularly for staffs and patient who coming to service. It will prevent diarrhea, typhoid fever and other diseases associated with contaminated water.

Beginning in 2012, in cooperation with Oudomxay Hospital, the L'association **Peuples et Montagnes du Mékong**, funded several missions for human resource development for local medical doctors and nurses to improve health care at provincial and district hospitals level, has provided mobile health care in remote areas of the health centers and also provided fund the Sustainable Comprehensive Water Project for Sibounheuang health center of Houn district.

This Storage Water Tank Construction Project is important and necessary for the continued success of facilities, health service, preventive healthcare in remote area.

This Project is a partnership between the Oudomxay Provincial Public Health Dept., in cooperation with the L'association **Peuples et Montagnes du Mékong** and **Amitiés Luxembourg-AmériqueLatinea.s.b.l**

II. OBJECTIVE

- The goal is to improve the service at health center and improve health of Akha people at Ano villages by giving them access to clean drinking water, better health care.
- To improve the health care, living conditions and the overall health of people in remote villages by giving them easy access to new health care center.

All building materials used for the construction of this project were of good quality obtained from one of **three bidding companies**.

V. ACTIVITIES PERFORM

1. Preparation

Cooperate with PEMM, Ministry of Health, Provincial, District and Village levels. Site surveyed on Deceber, 2015 by teamwork of La District Public Health and Dr. Phetsamone Indara (assistant coordinator of PEMM)

2. Construction

Work will start when PEMM approved under the management of the engineer of Oudomxay Provincial Public Health Dept., La District and Project Manager of PEMM.

There are 5 phases of construction:

- 1) Earth work
- 2) Concrete work
- 3) Stair work
- 4) Roofing work
- 5) Setting and painting works
